- The intern must be supervised within the company by a qualified and experienced supervisor, whose name is specified in the internship certificate.

Name of supervisor:

The internship should be completed within one department of the company. It should be dedicated, if possible, to a specific project identified by the company.

The company defines and communicates in writing to the person undertaking the internship:

- the conditions of remuneration taking into account the specificities and objectives of the internship as well as its formative nature
- the eventual fringe benefits
- the terms of suspension and termination
- the internal regulations and the terms of any social insurance contributions
- the conditions under which the intern is authorised to be absent, in particular in the framework of duties certified by the educational institution.

The present certificate is signed between the company represented by the supervisor, the intern and a representative of the University. This certificate ensures the recognition of the status of intern in the company.

Once his/her internship certificate is signed (or within the first two weeks of the internship at the latest), the intern must give a copy to the University representative and a copy to the supervisor.

The intern must be covered by health and accident insurance and must have personal liability insurance to cover the length of the internship. The University is relieved of any responsibility in this regard.
